Principle #1

**Choose humility
over anger**

Take Note

God has declared war on ego,
arrogance, and selfishness.



Take Note

Anytime pride gets a hold
of our lives, we can guarantee
we're working
in opposition to God.



Take Note

If you want God's help to reduce
conflict in your life,
start with humility.

When you're humble, you'll get
along better with your family.

Take Note

Satan wants to damage all of your relationships. He's ready to supply you with an arsenal of hurtful words the moment you get into a quarrel, which will only escalate your conflict to places you don't intend.



Take Note

Be aware that Satan has a plan to attack you when you're at your weakest and to push you to act emotionally rather than logically.



Get rid of all bitterness, rage, anger, harsh words, and slander, as well as all types of evil behavior. Instead, be kind to each other, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, just as God through Christ has forgiven you.
